Dear Parents and Carers,

This afternoon the Premier has announced new circuit breaker restrictions for Victoria to swiftly address the recent COVID-19 outbreak.

The restrictions will be in place from 11.59pm tonight for a five-day period.

Following advice from the Victorian Chief Health Officer, all Victorian schools will move to a period of remote and flexible learning from Friday 16th July to Tuesday 20th July inclusive.

Given the lateness of the announcement from The Premier, tomorrow's learning program will be a scaled down version. Classroom teachers will email families mid-morning of learning activities to undertake tomorrow.

Staff will use tomorrow to plan for remote learning for Monday 19th to Tuesday 20th July. These learning tasks will then be emailed to families on Sunday afternoon. Staff will also advise families how they will communicate with students during this period of remote learning.

As with other remote learning periods, our school will provide on-site supervision for students in the following categories:

- **Children where both parents and/or carers are authorised workers who cannot work from home, work for an essential provider and where no other supervision arrangements can be made:**
 - Where there are two parents/carers, both must be authorised workers, working outside the home in order for their children to be eligible for on-site provision
 - For single parents/ carers, the authorised worker must be working outside the home in order for their children to be eligible for on-site provision.
- **Children experiencing vulnerability, including:**
 - children in out-of-home care
 - children deemed vulnerable by a government agency, funded family or family violence service, and is assessed as requiring education and care outside the family home
 - children identified by a school or early childhood service as vulnerable, including via referral from a government agency, or funded family or family violence service, homeless or youth justice service or mental health or other health service.

If your child requires on-site supervision, please contact the office.

The same arrangements apply to our Outside School Hours Care service.
