## Return to face-to-face teaching and learning Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> July

Dear Parents and Carers,

The Victorian Government has announced new arrangements for schools in Victoria from and including Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> July 2021.

Based on advice from the Victorian Chief Health Officer, schools in Victoria will return to face-to-face learning and teaching for all students from and including Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> July 2021.

This means all students are expected to attend our school on-site from Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> July 2021.

All students are expected to attend on-site and our Outside School Hours Care (OSHC) program will also resume full operations from and including Wednesday 28<sup>th</sup> July 2021.

To keep our school safe, we have introduced some important operational changes. This includes:

- *Designated entry and exit points for students by surname (please see following page)*
  - *A-K – main entrance gate to school (Pascoe Street)*
  - *L-Z – West Street gate*
- *Non-essential visitors will not be allowed into school grounds*
- *All school gatherings such as assemblies and school events will be deferred*
- *Interschool activities are not permitted at this time*
- *Incursions are not permitted*
- *Excursions and our Grade 3/4 Camp will continue as scheduled*

### Face masks

There has been no change to the face mask advice, which will continue to apply to all school settings, including any Outside School Hours Care (OSHC) programs:

- Secondary school students aged 12 or older must wear a face mask at all times indoors and outdoors when at school, including when attending an OSHC program, unless a lawful exception applies.
- Children under 12 years of age and students at primary school are not required to wear face masks when at school, or when attending an OSHC program.
- Face masks are mandatory for all school students aged 12 or older on public transport and when in taxis or ride-share vehicles. This includes travelling to and from school on public transport or in a vehicle with others not from your household.

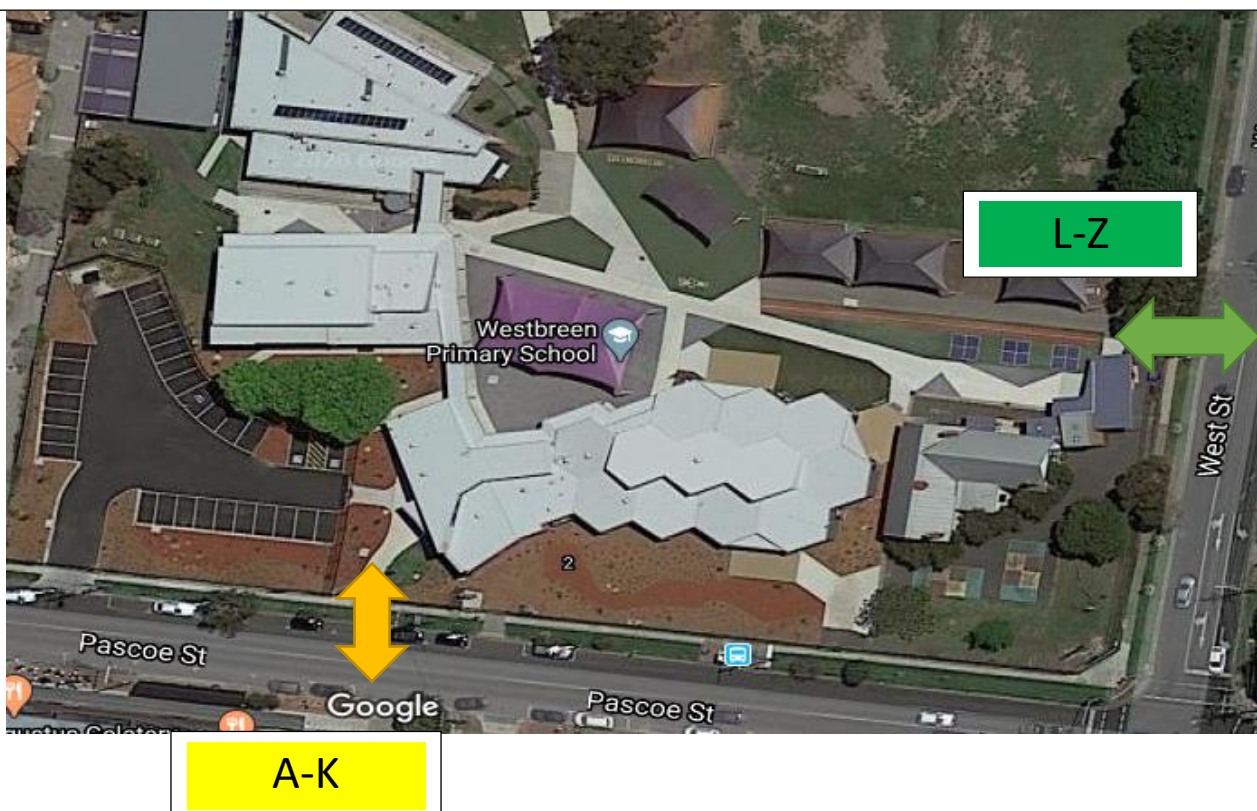

**START TIME: 9:00am**

**FINISH TIME: 3:15pm**

### **BEFORE SCHOOL DROP OFF**

- Drop off students at nominated gates in the morning (parents/carers only enter grounds if essential).

### **AFTER SCHOOL PICK UP**

- Gates open at 3:10pm to allow parents/carers to collect child/children from their nominated gate.
- All adults are to keep 1.5m between themselves and other adults and wear face masks.
- Please exit grounds immediately after students are collected.
- Any students that have not been collected by 3:30pm will then be directed to wait at the office.
