Roadmap to on-site learning

Dear Parents and Carers,

The Victorian Government has announced the Roadmap to Deliver the National Plan.

The Roadmap, which is based on advice from the Victorian Chief Health Officer, sets out the staged return to on-site learning in Term 4, with the plan being that all students returning on-site by Friday 5th November as follows:

This will, however, depend on final advice from health authorities closer to each stage.

For our school, this means that the following arrangements will be in place:

Foundation Classes: FA, FM, FV	From Monday 18th October	Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday
Grade 1/2 Classes: 1/2H, 1/2O, 1/2W, 1/2F, 1/2B	From Monday 18th October	Thursday & Friday
Grade 3/4 Classes: 3/4P, 3/4M, 3/4Z	From Tuesday 26th October	Tuesday & Wednesday
Grade 4/5/6 Classes: 4/5E, 5/6C, 5/6N, 5/6K	From Tuesday 26th October	Thursday & Friday

Remote and flexible learning will be delivered to students on the days they are not on-site.

Vulnerable children and children of parents or guardians who are on the authorised provider and authorised worker list can continue attending on-site.

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Outside School Hours Care (OSHC) programs will be open for all students during Term 4 in line with their return to on-site attendance at school.

A FEW REMINDERS FOR NEXT WEEK (18th Oct to 22nd Oct):

- **Foundation students** on-site Monday to Wednesday and Flexible & Remote Learning Thursday and Friday.
- **Grade 1/2 students** Flexible & Remote Learning Monday to Wednesday and on-site Thursday and Friday.
- **Grade 3-6 students** continue with Flexible & Remote Learning all week.
- The Flexible & Remote Learning Program for next week (Week 3) will be emailed to families by 4:00pm Sunday afternoon (except for **Foundation students** - they will be given a hard copy pack when on-site on Wednesday).
- **Specialist Days:** Wednesday for **Gr. 1/2 students**; Thursday for all other students. Specialist teachers will email these learning tasks to families on the Tuesday afternoon (19th October). Specialist teachers will also provide a link to view videos of the tasks.
- Specialist teachers will be unavailable to answer emails on the two Specialist Days as they will be involved in the on-site supervision program.
- Any **Gr. 3-6 students** on-site under vulnerable or authorised worker categories, **must** wear masks indoors. Parents/Carers to supply masks.
- Masks are recommended for students in Foundation to Gr. 2 students while indoors.
- **Masks are required to be worn by all adults on school grounds (unless a medical exemption applies).**
- Parents/Carers are encouraged to “kiss and drop” at school gates of a morning and of an afternoon, avoid congregation while waiting for their child/children. School gates will not be opened until 3:10pm.
- **Canteen will not be operating until further notice.**

Vaccination

Getting vaccinated is the best way to be protected from and prevent the spread of COVID-19. We encourage all students aged 12 years and over and their parents to get vaccinated as soon as possible. To book a vaccination appointment go to coronavirus.vic.gov.au.
