Dear Parents and Guardians,

It has been over a week since we have welcomed our Foundation, Grade 1 and Grade 2 students back to school under the Stage 1 phase of Return to School. It is with even further great excitement that we now prepare ourselves to welcome our Grade 3 to Grade 6 students back to school from Tuesday 9th June.

A reminder to all families that once a year level has returned, all students will be expected to attend school as normal. This means if you choose to keep your child/children home after their year level has returned to on-site schooling, we can no longer support their learning from home.

The greatest risk of transmission of COVID – 19 is between adults and as such, we will be taking every precaution necessary to avoid close contact between adults. We believe that we can maintain safe drop off and pick up from school without staggering start and finish times if we follow the correct safety requirements. **PLEASE TAKE NOTE OF THE DROP OFF & PICK UP GUIDELINES ON THE FOLOWING PAGE.**

Please note that enhanced cleaning of the school will remain in place for the remainder of Term 2 and Term 3. This will include frequent cleaning of high touch points and other surfaces throughout the day. Students will also be encouraged to wash their hands frequently and hand sanitiser is available in all classrooms.

- Students should not be bringing any personal belongings to school such as toys or sports equipment.

- All Term 2 excursions and incursions postponed or cancelled.
- 2021 Enrolments tours postponed.
- Playgroup cancelled until further notice.

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Drop off & Pick Up Points for students – STUDENT SURNAME

Tuesday 9th June – Friday 26th June



START TIME: 9:00am

FINISH TIME: 3:15pm

BEFORE SCHOOL DROP OFF

- Drop off students at nominated gates in the morning (parents/carers only enter grounds if essential).

AFTER SCHOOL PICK UP

- Gates open at 3:10pm to allow parents/carers to collect child/children from their nominated exit gate.
- Parents/Carers/Older Siblings of Foundation students can collect these students from the external doors of the classroom.
- All students in Grades 1-6 will be dismissed from their classroom and told to make their way to their nominated exit gate where they will meet an adult family member.
- All adults are to keep 1.5m between themselves and other adults.
- Please exit grounds immediately after students are collected.
- Any students that have not been collected by 3:25pm will then be directed to wait under the blue shade sail.
