Volunteering at Team Westbreen

Every year we invite our Westbreen families and community to join us by volunteering at Team Westbreen. We believe that when schools, families and communities work together to support our students it gives them the opportunity to thrive both academically and personally.

We understand our families are busy and don't have as much time to help as they may like so you may think it's not worth offering, but could I ask you to chat to me about what may work for you before you cross it off the list. It could be once a week, fortnightly or monthly, or maybe just every now and again. Any assistance we can get from our families and communities is appreciated AND our students love having you involved.

To be a volunteer at Team Westbreen there are two things you will need.

- 1. A current Working with Children Check (WWCC) card which is available online at www.workingwithchildren.vic.gov.au/individuals/applicants
 - There is no cost in getting a Volunteer WWC card (see below for more details)
- 2. Complete our Volunteer's Induction Program, which involves a short meeting with myself to explain what our program is and how it works.

We have 2 events coming up that we need volunteers for:

- 1. Bunnings BBQ on Saturday 24th Aug please note, you do not need a WWCC to volunteer for this event
- 2. Father's Day stalls on Friday 30th Aug which you will need a WWCC to volunteer at this event

Get your working with children check in Victoria

In Victoria, anyone over the age of 18 is required to hold a working with children check (WWCC) valid for paid work, self-employment or *volunteer work*.

The process can usually be completed fully online. You will need two identification documents (the easiest pair is usually a passport and driver's license but there are other options available). The process uses facial recognition on your smart phone to verify your identity.

During your online application you will verify your identity and complete your details. There is no fee for a Volunteers WWCC.

If you are unable to complete your application online you will need to <u>complete it manually</u> by visiting Australia Post.

The Victorian WWCC is valid for 5 years.
