### Principal's Message

Dear Westbreen PS Families,

As we approach the end of the term, I wanted to highlight a few recent and upcoming dates over weeks 8 and 9:

We also had our curriculum day last Friday, during which staff took a deep dive into our NAPLAN data and started to plan around how we could differentiate numeracy tasks further to support all learners. We also had professional learning on the Disability Inclusion initiative that will be introduced to the Merri-bek region in 2025. The day was centred around our students and supporting them in the classroom in their learning and wellbeing.

#### Booking an Appointment with a Teacher Outside of Conferences


