Reminder Booking an Appointment with a Teacher Outside of Conferences

If you wish to speak to your child's teacher outside of our scheduled Reporting Days, the easiest way to do so is by sending your child's teacher a message via XUNO requesting a convenient time to meet. A scheduled meeting allows our teaching staff to fully address any concerns or issues raised and support you and your child. Trying to speak your child's teacher by entering the classroom just before or during learning time, makes it difficult for teaching staff to adequately address your concerns whilst managing student learning and behaviour in the classroom.

All families are requested to ensure that pick up or walk home arrangements are made clear with your children so that there is no confusion at the end of the day.

Chickenpox update



Chickenpox (varicella) - update

For those families and caregivers who are after some additional information on Chickenpox (varicella) disease, please paste this link into your browser:

https://immunisationhandbook.health.gov.au/contents/vaccine-preventable-diseases/varicella-chickenpox Although children at 18months of age typically receive one dose of varicella-containing vaccine (Measels, Mumps, Rubella Vaccine) under the National Immunisation Program Schedule, it is also recommended that children 12 months to 14 years of age receive a second dose at least 4 weeks after the first dose; 2 doses of varicella-containing vaccine provide more protection and minimise the chance of breakthrough varicella in children less than 14 years of age, noting however that this second dose is NOT included on the national Immunisation Program Schedule and is typically administered by your local GP for a fee.

Important Info:

All students will get to participate in the Colour Fun Run on the day even if they haven't signed up OR raised any money, they just won't be eligible to receive or win any prizes along the way.

Students to wear free dress to school on the day. This can be any top that families are happy for them to have colour on. Please note:

A white t-shirt will show more of the coloured powder

It doesn't have to be a plain white top, it can have patterns or pictures etc. on it **BUT** it must be school appropriate

Students will need a hat to wear on the day. If you would prefer your child not to wear their Westbreen school hat, they can wear any Sun Smart hat that you are happy to have colour on

Please note – we have been assured the colour powder washes out in the wash.

The Colour Fun Run track will be the WPS running track on the oval.

3 large inflatables will be placed around the running track that the children will run through on the day Teachers will be throwing the powder on the children as they run past. All powder will be thrown at the children's bodies.

Students will wait in the middle of the oval for their year level to be called.

Parents are welcome to watch all the fun from around the outside of the oval.

Sliming teachers will take place throughout the event with the sliming pool placed in the middle of the oval so students and parents can easily watch both events throughout the afternoon.

Teachers will accompany their year level around the course.






Footy/Sports Colours Day:

Workshop Teacher:

Gloria Sulli is an Italian artist living in Melbourne. She studied sculpture in Florence and has Art Therapy as a postgraduate course. Her practice focuses on ceramic sculpture, inflatable sculptures and large-scale drawing. Her subjects are often organic shapes similar to animals, plants and corals as living breathing beings. Gloria's intention with her art is to bring art closer to life and us closer to other living beings. She has conducted several art workshops for children both in Italy and in the UK where she lived for seven years. In her workshops she experiments with different 2d techniques and 3d manipulation in the form of play.


