Dear Westbreen PS Families,

Here are the criteria we consider when establishing classes:

- The children's individual learning capabilities
- The known social, emotional, and physical stages of the individual child
- Friendship groupings, ensuring that each student is placed with at least one friend from their sociogram
- Balancing the number of males and females in each class
- Addressing the needs of English as an additional language learners and other special needs
- Creating classes with similar educational and behavioral profiles
- Anticipating growth in class numbers
- Ensuring compatibility of sub-groupings
- Considering the students' ability to cope with change.

For parents who wish to have input into their child's placement for 2025, please submit your requests in writing based on educational grounds. All requests must be received by Wednesday, October 30th, 2024, and should be addressed to Mr. Lania.

School Saver Bonus Information - Reminder

As shared with you previously, parents and carers of every child enrolled in a Victorian government school in 2025 will receive the one-off School Saving Bonus \$400 support. By Friday 18 October 2024, please ensure that your child's 2025 enrolment is completed and that your contact information is up to date.

In the coming months, the Department of Education will send you 2 email communications for each of your children enrolled in Victorian government schools.

The 2 emails from the Department of Education will be:

- 1. Confirm your email address between mid-October and late-November.
- 2. Provide you with your unique \$400 School Saving Bonus code by the end of November.

If you do not receive a confirmation email from the department by late-November, please check your spam or junk folders and contact the school if needed.

ITALIAN DAY ~ Wednesday 27/11/24

On Wednesday 27th November, 2024, all students and staff will have the opportunity to participate in the varied Italian events organised to celebrate our annual "Italian Day" at Westbreen P.S.

Both students and staff will be encouraged to dress up in costumes that depict the Italian culture and traditions from far away Italy. Some ideas could include the students dressing up as; Pinocchio, Romeo or Juliet, a pizza chef and waiters/ress, a carnival character such as Harlequin/*Arlecchino*, the Leaning Tower of Pisa, a jumbo size pizza or ice cream, Leonardo Da Vinci, Super Mario Brothers, a soccer player, Mona Lisa and Luciano Pavarotti. If time does not permit to come up with a costume, students are encouraged to wear the Italian colors red/rosso, white/bianco and green/verde on the day.

We will have a combined Wednesday assembly and parade, which will also include **Diana** our Italian singer performing once again for Team Westbreen. *Grazie* to Diana, who has kindly offered to perform once again for the whole school Westbreen community. Parents/guardians/family members are strongly encouraged to attend this **special** assembly. **You will not want to miss it!!**

The rest of the day will include a range of activities that will allow the students to learn about many different aspects of the Italian culture and language. Students will be split into two groups. F-2 and 3-6, whilst one group attends the bilingual show - <u>L'ingrediente Segreto</u>, a fun-filled interactive Italian education production, the other group will be involved in designing an *Italy and All Things Italian* class poster which will be shared at the end of the day at our final whole school gathering. After lunch, the groups will swap. This will ensure all students have the opportunity to participate in all the set activities planned for the day.

At lunchtime, students will all get to enjoy their lemon, strawberry, chocolate or vanilla *gelato*. The office staff has a full listing of ingredients of all 4 *gelati* if you require further information regarding the ingredients of any of the four *gelati*.
